- Ministry Helps

Any ministry ought to be able to clearly demonstrate, to any who might inquire, its "reason for being." It is no longer adequate to merely claim participation in the Great Commission activity of the Church, for that is the universal claim of almost every ministry. The width, breadth and depth of a ministry's spiritual impact is of singular importance in justifying its continuing existence. Midwest Church Extension is focused on helping local churches establish a biblical identity through a variety of ministry helps, and by endeavoring to inspire a burden for outreach that results in people being saved and discipled to serve Christ.



This Is What We Do...

Biblical Identity

The Scripture says that the Church is "the pillar and ground of the truth" (1 Tim. 3.15). Local churches must establish a biblical identity in order to fulfill this fundamental purpose. The common condition of the vast majority of local churches today is not one that reflects a biblical identity. Midwest Church Extension is committed to bringing a positive change to the current spiritual climate of today's Christianity at the local church level.

Sound Doctrine

Timothy was charged by Paul to "preach the Word" (2 Tim. 4.2). Paul also told Timothy to commit the Word to faithful men "who shall be able to teach others also" (2 Tim. 2.2). Such things are not accomplished without a commitment to sound doctrine. A search of the local listing of churches anywhere in the Midwest will demonstrate that churches committed to sound doctrine are far outnumbered by those that are not.



True Fellowship

A biblical identity also requires wholesome fellowship. Sound doctrine manifests its power through local churches made up of godly people involved in biblical service and worship of God. Today, local church fellowship ranges from being formally ritualistic to being emotionally driven. There is a great need for churches that have wholesome, biblical fellowship.

Offering a Service of Ministry Helps

Midwest Church Extension is committed to helping local

churches reach biblical goals by providing specific important helps.

Prayer Support

Jesus said, "Without me you can do nothing" (John 15.5). James said, "Ye have not, because ye ask not" (James 4.2). MCE provides a support network of praying leaders and churches. In intercession each church plant is placed before the Lord, beseeching Him to work in hearts, draw people to Himself, perfect His people, and prosper His work.

On-Site Personnel

Local churches need qualified leaders capable of guiding and directing them into fruitful ministry. MCE works to provide, for its churches, men who are called of God "for the perfecting of the saints" (Eph. 4.12). MCE has a team of men, experienced in pastoral and counseling ministry, who are equipped and ready to help churches realize their potential for Christ.

Financial Assistance

Many young and smaller churches cannot financially support a pastor on a full-time basis. As a faith mission, MCE provides a conduit through which church plants can receive the financial assistance needed to provide for a pastor. Interested churches, businesses and individuals can regularly contribute to the needs of such needy churches. MCE takes an active role in the advancement of solid, healthy, and vibrant Bible-believing churches.
